Six Indian institutes among 150 top think-tanks

New York, Feb 3 (PTI) Six Indian research institutes, including Centre for Civil Society (CCS), are among top 150 global think-tanks in the annual list released by the University of Pennsylvania for the year 2012.

Though no Indian think-tank figured in the top 50, New Delhi-based CCS was ranked 51st in the list.

The list was topped by Brookings Institution (United States) followed by Chatham House (United Kingdom) and Carnegie Endowment for International Peace (United States).
